

## Description of Change

The purpose of this errata notice is to notify Texas Education Agency (TEA) grant applicants and grant recipients of automatic grant extensions and changes to grant submission requirements due to operations being disrupted by COVID-19.

## Automatic Extensions for Application Due Dates and Final and Revised Expenditure Reports

All Grants Administration Division deadlines and due dates for grant applications and expenditure reports will automatically be adjusted as described below. Notice of Grant Award (NOGA) ending dates are not impacted at this time.

- Any deadline between now through April 10, 2020, is extended to April 20, 2020.
- Any deadline from April 11 through May 3, 2020, is extended two additional weeks.

Please note that further extensions may be issued as circumstances continue to evolve.

## Grant Application Submission Changes

Effective immediately TEA will only accept non-eGrants grant application documents by email, including competitive grant applications and amendments. Submit grant applications and amendments as follows:
