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#### **Summary of Program**

The LEA will support campuses in their improvement activities by allocating appropriate resources to their efforts. This will include establishing data review periods with both the District Administrative Team and Board to report progress and plan revisions. The district will continue to allocate financial resources to programs and activities that are producing improvement results while discontinuing ineffective and inefficient activities. The district will also adopt a web-based improvement plan that will be utilized by all campuses regardless of their eligibility. The district has identified utilizing "Data Driven Instruction" as its focus for school improvement efforts.

2. Describe how the LEA will monitor schools receiving the ESF-Focused Support Grant, including how the LEA will: (a) Monitor a web-based improvement plans upon submission and during implementation, and (b) Implement additional action following unsuccessful implementation of such plan after the first year of the grant cycle.

The district will establish an accountability calendar that will be broken down into four quarters or operational periods. The expectation will be established that each campus plan will identify strategies and tactics that will be utilized during each operational period. The strategies and tactics will be based on objectives written to meet priorities identified through the needs assessment process. Interim evaluation measures or targets will also be identified prior to the beginning of the current operational period to be used to measure effectiveness. It will also be an expectation that there will be a post-operational review by each campus team to measure progress and make necessary adjustments. At the conclusion of the last operational period, the entire plan and final results will have been reviewed to determine if efforts have been deemed successful or not. Based on these findings, the plan will be revised to meet new needs that have been identified or continue current effective efforts.

process. General supplies will also be budgeted to acquire high level curriculum materials that are aligned with the TEKS.
