Overview

2. **ENROLLED GRADE LEVEL CODE** – Field name changed from “Grade Level Code” and is captured on the last day of the TELPAS test window (Position 5)
3. **FALL 2022 TSDS PEIMS HOMELESS-STATUS-CODE** – New field from the PEIMS database (Position 110)
4. **SECTION 504-INDICATOR-CODE** – New field added in TIDE (Position 112)
5. **AGENCY USE CODES** – These fields will be populated in 2023 (Positions 133 – 137)
6. **RATER INFO A** – Value of 8 (a centralized rater for grades 2-12) is no longer an acceptable value (Position 201)
7. **READING AND WRITING DESIGNATED SUPPORTS** – Field label updated to include embedded writing domain test (Position 241)
8. **READING AND WRITING EXTRA DAY** – Field label updated to include embedded writing domain test (Position 243)
9. **WRITING SPEECH-TO-TEXT** – New field for Writing test speech-to-text (Position 245)
10. **WRITING REPORTING CATEGORY 1 SCORE** – New field for writing domain reporting category 1. *Note: There are 24 points possible in grades 2-3 and 36 points possible in grades 4-12* (Position 431)
11. **WRITING REPORTING CATEGORY 2 SCORE** – New field for writing domain reporting category 2 (Position 433)
12. **WRITING RAW SCORE** – New field for writing domain raw score (Position 435)
13. **WRITING SCALE SCORE** – New field for writing domain scale score (Position 437)
14. **WRITING HOLISTIC RATING TEST ADMINISTRATION** – New field for writing domain (Position 441)
15. **WRITING REPORTING CATEGORY NUMBERS BY ITEM** – New field indicating the reporting category for each item (Position 447)
16. **WRITING POINTS POSSIBLE BY ITEM** – New field indicating maximum points possible for each item in the writing domain (Position 457)
17. **WRITING POINTS ACHIEVED BY ITEM** – New field indicating the points a student achieved on each item in the writing domain (Position 477)
18. **READING CORRECT RESPONSE BY ITEM** – TELPAS test will be released in 2023 (Position 771)
19. **LISTENING STUDENT RESPONSE BY ITEM** – TELPAS test will be released in 2023 (Position 851)
20. **BLANK** – Added to replace Yearly Progress Indicator, which will not be reported in 2023 (Position 888-904)
21. **NON-PARTICIPANT ONLINE REFUSAL READING/WRITING** – Field label updated to include embedded writing domain test (Position 1152)

For students who do not complete testing at the same grade level in all four domains, a Composite Score or Composite Rating cannot be calculated, and the students will be reported in the data file with multiple records.
