We have received the enrollment form requesting SES services for your child. Financial requirements through NCLB allow us to provide SES services to a certain number of students. Due to the overwhelming requests for SES services, Sample ISD will be applying the eligibility criteria described in the cover letter of our parental notification packet. The parental notification packet stated:

In the event the number of requests for this free tutoring exceeds the amount of money the district has to pay for the SES tutoring services, the district must set priorities in order to determine which eligible student will receive the free SES tutoring. If this should occur, the district will have to implement their priorities criteria. Sample ISD will use the following criteria:

September 2009- February 5, 2010- All Sample HS students from low income families.

February 8, 2010- March 30, 2010- All Sample HS students who scored less than 2100 on their TAKS Math assessment and are not already served. Students in grade 10 will receive first priority followed by 9th graders then 11th and 12th graders.

March 31, 2010- June 4, 2010- All Sample HS students who scored less than 2000 on their TAKS Math assessment and are not already served. Students in grade 10 will receive first priority followed by 9th graders then 11th and 12th graders.

Your child does not qualify for free SES tutoring for the following reasons:

- 1. _____Your child does not meet low-socio economic status.
- 2. _____Your child passed his/her TAKS Math Assessment.
- 3. ____Your child did not pass his/her Math Assessment; however, there are other students that scored lower on their assessments.

If by March 31, 2010 the remaining slots have not been filled, the students that were excluded because of reason 3 will be assigned to those slots in the order they were received. Once assigned, you will be contacted by the SES provider.
