Employment of Initially Certified Teachers 2016-17 through 2021-22

This report shows the number of candidates who obtained initial standard teaching certificates through each preparation route, followed by the number and percentage who were employed as teachers in Texas public schools for the following academic year. The table also shows a pooled result for all routes. We excluded teachers whose role indicated they were a permanently employed substitute teacher from the calculations.

Definitions: An initial teaching certificate is a standard teaching certificate issued to a teacher who was not previously issued a standard or lifetime teaching certificate. Standard certificates, as defined in <u>19 TAC Chapter 230</u>, are certificates offered since September 1, 1999 that are renewed every five years. The academic year is determined by the date of issuance. An academic year is defined as September 1 through August 31 of the following calendar year.

Methodology: We identified all standard teaching certifications that were issued since September 1, 2016 to educators who did not previously hold a standard or lifetime teaching certification from the administrative data in the Educator Certification Online System (ECOS). These initial certifications were assigned to the academic year in which they were issued. All teachers were categorized into one of the four mutually exclusive routes through which they obtained their initial certification.

Note: In our effort toward continuous improvement in data accuracy, we have updated our methodology and programming for identifying the program of the initial certification to better align with the practices of Educator Certification department. Due to these improvements, numbers reported herein may be significantly different from those reported in previous years and should not be considered comparable with reports from prior years.
