## TO THE ADMINISTRATOR ADDRESSED:

SUBJECT: Required *RF Tracker* Data Collection for Districts with Residential Care and Treatment Facilities within Their Geographic Boundaries and/or Jurisdiction

The purpose of this letter is to notify local education agencies (LEAs) of timelines related to the required collection of data for students with disabilities, who reside in residential care and treatment facilities (RFs) within the geographic boundaries or jurisdiction of a district. In a Texas Education Agency (TEA) letter dated October 12, 2016, districts were informed that, during the 2016-2017 program year, districts would continue to use the *RF Tracker* data collection system to enter data from RF districts. **Districts must complete the 2016-2017 data collection no later than June 12, 2017**.

LEAs that are required to complete the data collection can request access to the *RF Tracker* application through the Texas Education Agency Secure Environment (TEASE) by completing an on-line request form. Instructions for establishing access are available on the TEA website at <a href="http://tea.texas.gov/About\_TEA/Other\_Services/Secure\_Applications/TEA\_Secure\_Applications\_Information/">http://tea.texas.gov/About\_TEA/Other\_Services/Secure\_Applications/TEA\_Secure\_Applications\_Information/</a>. LEA users who work within a shared services arrangement (SSA) and need access to the application on behalf of more than one LEA must submit a PDF application. The SSA application can downloaded from the TEA website link referenced above. For those districts with residential care and treatment facilities within their boundaries or jurisdiction, in which students with disabilities have resided during the 2016-2017 school year, the due date for the completion of the *RF Tracker* data collection is **June 12, 2017**. However, the end-of-year date for districts reporting that students with disabilities reside in an RF is **on or before May 12, 2017**.
