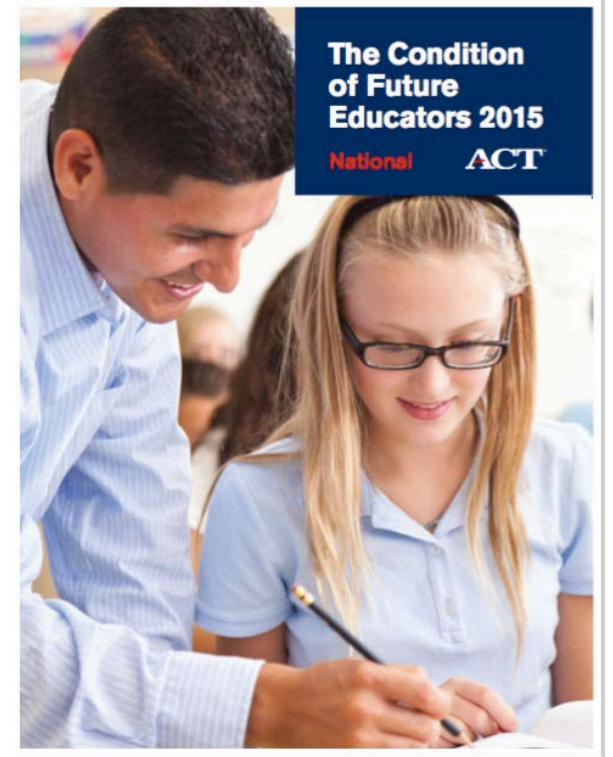

Motivations for teaching: which of these can we influence?



- **Perceived teaching abilities**
 - *I have the qualities of a good teacher*
- **Prior teaching and learning experiences**
 - *I have had inspirational teachers*
- **Opportunity to enhance social equity**
 - *Teaching will allow me to raise the ambitions of under-privileged youth*
- **Opportunity to shape future of children/adolescents**
 - *Teaching will allow me to influence the next generation*
- **Opportunity to make a social contribution**
 - *Teaching allows me to provide a service to society*
- **Opportunity to work with children/adolescents**
 - *I like working with children/adolescents*

1) Provide grant funds to support teachers to **pursue a Master's degree** and eventually offer these high school courses as **dual enrollment** – using curricular resources developed by **expert teachers**

2) Tuition stipends for your current **paraprofessionals** to become teachers

3) Stipends for college **student teachers** to be paid for a year of clinical teaching
