IDENTIFY

Identify who will serve as your
official non-profit representative
(a non-profit can be a PTA, an ISD
Foundation, a food bank, a
church, etc)



RECEIVE



Food collected on campus
may include unopened,
uneaten surplus food, from
breakfast, lunch, snack and
dinner programs, as well as
food drives

STORE



Secure a specific location
where the donated food will be
stored on campus (all food
safety standards apply)

REDISTRIBUTE



Determine the time and
process of distribution for
donated food on your
campus
